



RULES OF EXHIBITION

All paintings hung in the Gallery must be for sale except for paintings by youth students.

All work displayed in the Gallery on the Square or at its' satellite exhibit spaces is on a consignment basis with the MAAA deducting a 20% commission from the selling price for MAAA members, a 40% commission for nonmembers. A 30% commission will be deducted from artists who are members of an organization with an organizational membership during that organization's show at the Gallery.

Although the greatest possible care will be taken in handling all artwork, the Gallery on the Square and the MAAA do not accept responsibility for any damage or theft which may occur. All art work is exhibited at the artist's risk.

Lifetime, Artist, and Student Members may exhibit in all member exhibits as well as maintain unframed 2D work for sale in racks provided for this purpose. 3D work will be displayed throughout the Gallery as space allows. A Patron Member may upgrade to an Artist Membership at any time.

All artwork must be the artist's original work or prints of the artist's original work.

All work intended for hanging must be suitably framed with proper hanging devices; eye hooks and wire. Oil and acrylic paint must be dry.

All work intended for display in the bins must have a rigid backing and be wrapped in clear protective covering.

The MAAA has the right not to hang or display any work for any reason. Reasons may include appropriateness, size, volume of work, inadequate hanging hardware, or any other reason. (Note: We do not accept ratchet type device for hanging.)

The MAAA does not accept items made with a 3D printer.

Each artist is responsible for keeping a record of their works exhibited. A binder is provided on the desk for that purpose. It is up to the artist to keep the information current.

Each artist is responsible for placing a tag on each item. The tag shall include the artist name, title of work, and selling price of the item.

All art work submitted must remain hanging until the end of the exhibit or until sold.

At the conclusion of each exhibit, work should be removed promptly except by mutual agreement of the MAAA and the artist.

MAAA members who exhibit at any time during the year are encouraged to Gallery sit at least once a month. Exhibiting nonmembers are also encouraged to Gallery sit during their show.

No paintings should be brought in after the show has been hung and/or be hung by the artist. All paintings shall remain where the hanging committee has placed them. Artists will not be permitted to be present while the committee is hanging the show. Artists cannot dictate or encourage the placement of artwork. It will be left solely to the discretion of the committee.
